

Literacy: We will be continuing our phonics learning, focusing on single sounds and oral blending of these sounds in words, increasing fluency of reading. Please check Dojo to see what these are each week.

Maths: In maths we will be developing spatial reasoning skills, by exploring 2D and 3D shape and recognizing these in the environment. Using 'first, then and now' number stories for simple subtraction and introducing the part-whole model to show number bonds to 5.

Understanding of the world: As part of our celebrations topic, foundation children will be learning about what times are special to people and why. With a specific focus on Diwali and Christmas.

Expressive arts and design: As always we will be creative each day using a variety of tools, techniques and materials with a focus on mark making and patterns.
